In your experience, what areas of the bushfire emergency response worked well?

In your experience, what needs to change to improve arrangements for preparation, mitigation, response and recovery coordination for national natural disaster arrangements in Australia?

The Australian National party partners in state governments will keep these unreformed state government conservation monopolies but complain about the damage for political gain as they have done for decades.

The Australian greens political party will advocate for more monopoly and more wasted taxpayers money to preserve their socialist base.

Unless of course all of the above become liable for prosecutions when they are involved in the next major disaster coming to Australia's public lands . That is politicians and scientists being prosecuted for negligence like they should be now.

The federal police should now be investigating and charging the individuals above who are getting away with deliberate actions via policies that burn people alive and incinerate the environment this past summer.
